To apply, eligible members must complete this scholarship application form. Applicants must:

- ✓ Complete the application form,
- ✓ TYPE or PRINT your application responses clearly.
- ✓ Use only the spaces provided on the application form to answer the questions. Other than specified, do not submit attachments, resumes, pictures or other materials to answer any of the questions.
- ✓ Attach a typed essay response (double spaced, please)
- ✓ Attach an official ACT/PSAT/SAT high school transcript with the student's GPA for grades 9-11 (and grade 12, if possible). This should be obtained through your high school guidance office.
- ✓ Attach a signed Certification and Release Authorization Form. This form is located on the back page of this application packet and must be signed by both the student and his/her parent.

Application Evaluation

- ✓ Part I - Academic Performance/Transcript
- ✓ Part II – Extracurricular and Community Activities/Awards/Leadership/Service
- ✓ Part III – Essay Response

Each application will be evaluated without the committee’s knowledge of the applicant’s identity or school district. A score of 1-5 will be assigned to each of the three parts of the scholarship application. The maximum score possible is 15 points. The committee will determine the dollar amount awarded for each scholarship based upon this evaluation process.
